Day students start at the beginning of each month. Day classes are held, Monday to Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm (approximately 10 months).

Evening classes are held, Wednesday and Thursday, 5:00pm to 9:30pm and Saturday 9:30am to 4:00pm (approximately 23 months). Evening students begin the first Wednesday of each month.

- The Ontario Student Loans Plan (OSL)


